



As of September 3rd, app-based ride-hailing and delivery workers will be eligible to receive workers' compensation benefits for work-related injuries and illness including health care, wage-loss, and rehabilitation benefits

More people will benefit from training grants

People training for good paying, in-demand careers will be able to access grants that cover most, or all, of their tuition thanks to the next intake of the StrongerBC future skills grant. This popular grant covers as much as \$3,500 in eligible short-term skills training at public post-secondary institutions.

More trained workers will improve mental-health, addictions care in B.C.

People looking for skills training and job opportunities in mental-health and addictions care are now able to access free education and paid work experience in the sector.

Unclear how end of B.C.'s vaccine mandate could impact staffing shortages

The mandate impacted clinical and non-clinical health-care workers. The decision means that 2,692 health-care workers could return to work after having lost their jobs for refusing to follow the mandate.
