Pay Transparency Laws: BC Employment Standards

As of November 1, 2023, all employers in B.C. must include the expected pay or the expected pay range for a specific job opportunity that they advertise publicly.

For example:

- \$20 per hour meets the requirements
- \$20-\$30 per hour meets the requirements
- \$40,000 per year meets the requirements
- \$40,000 \$60,000 per year meets the requirements
- \$20 per hour and up does not meet the requirement
- Up to \$30 per hour does not meet the requirement

The **Pay Transparency Act** was passed on May 11, 2023 and places new requirements on employers to address systemic discrimination in the workplace. Background information on pay transparency and gender pay gap is available by viewing the **discussion paper**.
