Hiring? Training?

The WorkBC Wage Subsidy Program may be a fit



The **Wage Subsidy Program** reimburses a portion of wage expense to employers who commit to providing a new employee who is a WorkBC Client, with on-the-job training, coaching and skill development.

All *unemployed BC Residents who may benefit from on-the-job training to gain work experience, may register to be a WorkBC Client.

Over the last 5 years, 116 businesses and not-for profit organizations, and 395 residents in our communities have benefitted from this funding program. The average value of an agreement has been just over \$9,100 and most are for 21-24 weeks.

Ready to apply for the subsidy? Use your ***BCEID** (Basic or Business) to complete the online application (this takes about 10 minutes).
